- Hired a local bookkeeper and accountant to maintain accurate financial report documents for AGLC and CAD Financial Audited Statement. COMPLETED

- Applied for Charitable Registration Number to become a registered Charitable Organization. COMPLETED
- Fundraised funds for new building reserve fund. These funds are payable for other costs that is not AGLC eligible expenses allowed to be used by Use of Proceed Gaming Funds. Example: Lawyer fees, land title fees, transfer of ownership fees, Non-Profit Organization business licenses, and etc. COMPLETED
- Set up new Building Committee to investigate options, research the needs of CAD members and purchase a new building as a centre for promoting social, educational, recreational and wellness for the Deaf. With the building purchase, renovations will be completed if needed to provide appropriate accessibility for the Deaf by December 31, 2019. COMPLETED
- Updated Bylaws to match current modern society and new building governance. COMPLETED
